Mr. Walder shared that he was pleased with the positive manner of the progression of the preparation of the budget; which is to everyone's credit – the Health Board as well as the individuals performing the day-to-day operations. It was commented that the addition of footnotes proved helpful with interpreting and understanding the shifting of sources of revenues into the appropriate area; as the process tends to skew the historic data of the numbers. The Budget Commission thanked Karolyn for putting the budget together in the county financial software.

In response to a State mandate the Health Department is researching the plan of implementing an annual inspection fee. This cost will be an assessment to all taxpayers that have residential private septic treatment systems. The Health Department is projecting the fee to be approximately \$25/annually. This program could eliminate the "transfer upon sale" septic inspection.
