Pursuant to R.C. 2151.10, 2151.40, and 319.16(A)(2), this order hereby directs timely payment by the Geauga County Auditor in the amount of \$ 87.50 (Eighty Seven Dollars and Fifty Cents) from 1001-007-00-601 to JEFFREY T ORNDORFF CO LPA, at PO BOX 1137, CHARDON, OH 44024-5137, for attorney's fees for 21PN122, which the Juvenile Court has determined to be an expenditure for a proper public purpose.
