Geauga Park District update – The Commission determined a follow-up letter to the letter dated 5/1/23 was in order. The letter will be drafted and reviewed by the Commission at the next meeting.

The Commission considered whether or not to have a work session once the 2024 Budgets have been received. If agreed, the session would be held during the first meeting in August. Additionally, the Commission was in agreement that the budget hearings documents which have been sent to the taxing districts in years prior are adequate.
